**READING OF THE MINUTES:**

1. Christmas Parade-Sandra Gowan reported to council the need for a council float to be entered in the parade on December 14, 2002. Council Member David Rogers says he will ask Robert Williams for the use of his truck and trailer to use as a float.

Candy Canes will be placed on telephone poles within the municipality on Saturday, November 23, 2002 at 10:00 a.m. everybody's help is needed.
2. South Carolina Department of Transportation was mailed a request for different types of roadwork needed within the town in January 2002. One request was double yellow lines throughout Reidville Road in the town and line markings on Reidville Road and Gaston Drive. The two requests were completed on Friday, November 8, 2002.
3. County Park plan on Gano Road and Dillard Road. Council Member Gregg Gowan is to speak with County Representative Rock Adams.
4. Annexation of Orchard View—The petition is ready. Mayor Snow hasn't contacted any of the residents at this time.

5. Library Committee—Council Member Charles Engroos asks his wife, Ann to be on the committee, no response was received. No other contacts were made.

#### **COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS AND DEPARTMENT REPORTS:**

1. Turning Lanes at Hwy 296 and Reidville Road---Town Clerk spoke with SCDOT on Friday November 8, 2002. The environmental study has been released and the project will continue. SCDOT is studying the placement of the turning lanes.
2. “Reason for the Season” –Sandra Gowan requests from council to have a special event that would be held at Town Hall on December 7, 2002 between the hours of 3:00 and 5:00 p.m. The event will consist of a tree decorating, refreshments, choir singing carols and local pastors to present the Reason for the Season. Mayor Snow recommended having a Christmas Stroll along Spring, Pine, College, and Main Street. Funds will be needed for lights and food.
