

COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS AND DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

1. Mayor Snow and Council Member Gregg Gowan met with Fred Berry, Steve Quinn of the SCDOT and House District #35 representative Phil Sinclair to discuss the new plans for the intersection located at Duncan Reidville Road and Reidville Road. The new plans are to bring the intersection further to the north side of Reidville Road. The store building front overhang will be shortened and road will continue along the property of the Burchsteads and decrease before the property owned by the Howard's. Cement curbing will be installed and piping will be installed from Duncan Reidville Road along Reidville Road and connect to the existing pipe under Leonard Drive. The work may begin as early as 2004.
2. Mayor Snow will represent the town at the Spartanburg County Council Meeting that will be held April 21, to present the proposal of annexing the County owned property located on Dillard Road and Gano Drive.
3. The Planning Commission is still working on the plans for the sidewalk and decorative street lights on College and Main Street. This process is going to be very slow.
4. Duke Power has contacted the town about the signing of the contract for the additional streetlights to be installed. The installation should begin in the very near future.
5. Sandra Gowan reported to Council that the overall Environmental Clean Up Day was a success. More participation from citizens needs to be encouraged. The need for some type of communication other than the newsletter
