There will be 6 on Reidville Road 2 on River Ridge, 2 on Duncan Reidville Road, 2 on Lightwood Knot Road, 2 on Reidville Sharon Road, 1 on Magnolia, 1 on Dillard Road, 1 on Yank Drive, 1 at Main Street and Willow Street, 1 at Pine Street and Gaston Drive, 1 at Spring Street and Pine Street, Poplar Street and Pine Street, Chestnut Street and Gaston Drive, and 1 in Cemetery. Remove light between Spring Street and Poplar Street, which is a total of 23 streetlights.

3. Website and purchase of Domain Name. Uptown from MASC has an article pertaining to the purchasing of a domain name for municipalities. The names are .gov and .us. Lifetime registration is \$395.00, 5 year \$180.00, 3 year \$168.00 and Permanent reservation but not activation for \$152.00. The money will come from the Contingency Fund.
