**OFFICIAL MINUTES OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
MAY 12, 2003**

READING OF THE MINUTES:

The minutes of the April 14, 2003 were not prepared.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Annexation of the county park---Mayor Snow met with Spartanburg County Council with the request for annexation of the county park. The counties main concern was what would be the regulations on the land use if a park were not built. Town attorney Frank Adams was concerned about the surveying of the property. An updated survey was completed a few years back when the county purchased the property. He also faxed Resolution #001-03. A resolution to accept the annexation.  
**Council Member Gregg Gowan made a motion to accept Resolution #001-03 as written.  
Second: Council Member David H. Rogers, Jr. All in favor  
Resolution #001-03 was adopted on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 2003.**
2. Roofing update---The roofing of town hall is complete. Mayor Snow has a few questions about the flashing on front and on the backside a piece of angle is not straight. Overall the roof looks 100% better. Citizen Chuck Gowan recorded the roofing process. A few wooden shingles was kept for the town.
3. Deputy Appreciation Day has been rescheduled for June 22, 2003. Waiting on the return of Town Clerk.
4. Driveway upgrade---Council member Gregg Gowan spoke with Randy Floyd and he will contact Sandra.
5. Litter Ordinance---Mayor Snow hasn't anything written on this item.
6. Firearm Ordinance---The Planning Commission was going to discuss this, but no meeting was held.

7. Council Member Evelyn Mull says she looked on the Internet and found a wrecker service that would haul old abandoned cars.

**COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS AND DEPARTMENT REPORTS:**

1. Sidewalk Enchantment Grant—Bob Bourguignon spoke with the Mayor about what he would like to see for the sidewalk. He would like to see 6 to 8 feet of grass between the sidewalk and road with lighting, stones and benches. He would like council and planning to meet when he gets a price quote on the project. His proposal would be to go all the way to the ballfield on both sides.
2. Streetlight update—Contract has been signed. Joanne Barr from Kuke Power says due to the rain the installation is on delay.
3. Residents of Sugar Tit update on the meeting held April 22, 2003. The committee will be passing out flyers in their area. The amount of area will stretch the maybe to far.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. A letter was received from Town Attorney Frank Adams about the town cemetery.. He has a lot of good item in the letter. Council Member Gregg Gowan made a suggestion once the Cemetery Ordinance is adopted then mail the ordinance to all area mortuaries. The cemetery needs to be posted non-perpetual care. A cemetery administrator is needed. A lay out of the graves will have to be completed. A requirement for a marker to be placed at a given time. No fences or coping. An administrative fee needs to be charged.  
**Council Member Gregg Gowan made a motion to purchase a sign to post on the cemetery, non-perpetual care. Second: Council Member Charles Engroos All in favor**
2. Tree removal at the cemetery---Pine beetles have killed some pine trees and the wind has ablown the trees on the neighbor's fence. Pittman Tree Service gave a price of between \$1100.00 and \$1200.00 to cut trees and remove fallen trees. Mayor Snow will check with other companies. A special meeting may be called once the quotes have been received.
