

1. **Annual Clean Up Day:** The clean up day held on April 14, 2004 was not as good as previous years. Need a different strategy next year to attract volunteers. Town Clerk Sandra Gowan suggested next year for her to go to residents on all the streets within the municipality drafting volunteers to pick up litter on their streets at a given time on the Clean Up Day.
