**READING OF THE MINUTES:**

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**1. 1<sup>ST</sup> READING OF PROCUREMENT ORDINANCE #0601:** Council reviewed Procurement Ordinance #0601. (See Attached) An ordinance creating the position of purchasing agent and establishing procedures of the Town of Reidville.
