**INVOCATION:**

**HOUSE DISTRICT #35 KEITH KELLY:**

We adjourned last Thursday at 5:00 p.m. There is a couple of veto's that we will have to go back and deal with week after next. Immigration Bill that we passed was signed by the Governor has already taken affect. Education, we took out the pact testing requirement.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

- 1. ZONING APPEALS BOARD MEMBER (1):** Mayor Snow did not get a chance to talk with Andy Burns.
- 2. COMPETITIVE GRANT (STREETSCAPE & SEWER) (NO DATE FOR GRANT HAS BEEN SET)** Hopefully the committee will be meeting sometimes soon.
- 3. SPAT COMMITTEE:** We did the presentation with SPATS and met with the advisory committee on Main St. Council Member Gowan, myself, Sandra, Bob Bourguignon and Asa Duckworth as a citizen was in attendance. They looked at what we had already done and asked what we wanted to do. They were reviewing all the projects that were underway in the different municipalities. I didn't have any hope that we would receive any grant money but a phone call message that the advisory committee had recommended to the full committee that we receive \$89,000.00. They also said that the full committee has never rejected the advisory

committee's recommendation. If we get some from CTC and the Competitive Grant maybe we will have covered it all. .

**COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS AND DEPARTMENT REPORTS:**

1. **STREETScape PROJECT (CONSTRUCTION):** The construction is complete and all that needs to be done is the 4 lampposts that are not burning. The broken glass will be replaced by the town. A tree needs to be trimmed near a lamppost. Overall we've had positive comments about what has been done.
2. **BEAVERS:** No beavers has been seen since the trapper Mr. Hoffman trapped 7 beavers. Water is running and its below the pipe. The beavers will come back but we'll handle them.
3. **MAINTENANCE ON MAIN STREET BIDS:** This item should not have been on the agenda. The bid was awarded to Clyde Bridwell at the May meeting. He is doing a good job.
4. **CTC STREEScape REQUEST:** Eddie Speed hasn't contacted us.
5. **2008 ENHANCEMENT GRANT APPLICATION FOR PHASE II AND III:** This item was discussed in Old Business Item #3.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Mayor Snow address the Planning Commission there was a need to look at signs, land use, chicken houses, hog farms, 24 hour business's and so forth. Council Member David Rogers said while we are on New Business we need to look at our handicap ramp.

Council Member Gregg Gowan said we needed to think about improvements to the town hall. Mayor Snow said that council needs to look at a workshop to discuss these improvements.
